a Mobile Rapid Response Prototype (MRRP), an anti-terrorism initiative that serves as a model for similar programs nationwide. "Northern New Jersey is home to what the FBI described as 'the most dangerous two-mile stretch in America,' "Torre explains. "Hackensack University Medical Center is just seven miles from the George Washington Bridge, so we are prepared to respond to any incident in the Greater New York Metropolitan Area and New Jersey. In fact, our fleet has just received airworthy certification from the Air Force, so that it is possible to be deployed anywhere in the country." As part of the MRRP, the hospital has six vehicles, plus another one under construction. Our fleet includes two 43-foot fully equipped trailers outfitted with seven beds in each, designed to provide advanced trauma care at the scene of a mass casualty event. There are also vans for equipment, pharmaceuticals, and personnel. A third trailer, a 45-foot custom-designed surgical suite, is expected for delivery by year's end. "We have participated in a series of multi-agency training exercises," says Torre. "We're staffed and ready to go. When activated, we can be deployed to the scene within one to three hours of an incident. We're really proud of that."

Looking Ahead

Even while the Foundation is forging ahead with such major campaigns as The Touchdown Fund, it has its sights set on other opportunities to assist the hospital in its aims for excellence. "We're already looking down the road to the next big project," Torre says proudly. "We're looking to significantly expand our Emergency Trauma Department, because we currently have one of the busiest Emergency Departments in the country. That's just us—we never take a break!"




